

## **Open Call Datscha Radio: Streuobstradio (OrchardFruitRadio)**

**Autumn** is green and red and golden, rich in scents and tastes, a time for the gathering and sharing of fruits and experiences. With **Streuobstradio** we want to celebrate this harvest time in sounds and stories amidst the trees of the historical orchard close to the Big Pond in Altenburg, Thuringia.

**From 2 to 6 pm on Thanksgiving Day, October 1, 2023**, we will be broadcasting directly from a Thuringian orchard. What is this sound of apples dropping into the wet grass? Of the spores floating amongst pollen and dirt? What recipe did your grandma use for her plum jam? What are sounds of the pleasures of harvesting the goods of the garden? Datscha Radio wants to find out – and needs your radiophonic autumn treasures!

### **Streuobstradio (OrchardFruitRadio)**

Datscha Radio asks you to focus on the activities, memories and scents of autumn and their possible metamorphoses into sound and music. We'll broadcast on micro FM across a historical orchard, with sound boxes dangling from the trees. Your acoustic seeds will pollinate the airs and ears of passer-bys and radio guests.

Please submit your audio piece until the 25<sup>rd</sup> of September 2023

There is no fixed time schedule. It is planned to assemble your (longer) pieces into loops to resound from loudspeakers in the trees. Some (shorter) pieces will become part of the live radio programm. You'll find a list of all participating artists on the Datscha Radio website in due time.
